A common sense approach to performing a proper brake job per 49 CFR 396.25(d)(3)(ii)(A):

Description of the seminar:

- How to disassemble the wheel to take a complete analytical look at the components

- Proper installation of brake chamber assembly and proper cutting of the push rod and slack mounting
